

theChapel Connect Group Leader: Expectations

Scope of the Role: Lead and facilitate conversation and cultivate community while helping group members further their walk with God

Exemplify theChapel Values as it pertains to leadership within Groups:

- 1. Know God:** I spend time in the word and prayer.
- 2. Find Freedom:** I am fully involved in groups and building relationships.
- 3. Discover your purpose:** I have gone through Growth Track and learned more about my giftings.
- 4. Make a Difference:** Committed to serving our church.

Requirements:

- Attend weekend services.
- Complete Growth Track.
- Pass a background check.
- Be consistent givers.

Expectations:

- Reach out to every group member via text prior to your first group meeting
- Create a culture of fun & a safe place for people to connect:
 - Participate in Serve Day when available as a group
- Pray first
- Be prepared:
 - Have a clear plan for how your time will be spent — allow for appropriate relational time and discussion — being conscientious of a 2 hour max meeting time
 - Make sure meeting location is clean, accessible, and has enough seating
 - No serving of alcohol at Connect Group events
 - Provide reminders, announcements, and any important info to your members weekly
- Develop relationships with your members inside and outside of your group
- Regularly communicate with your Team Lead — give updates of hits & misses, ask group related questions, seek out feedback & tell them how they can pray for you!
- Take attendance
- Look for potential leaders within your group: give them opportunities to lead within your group during the semester & invite them to attend the next Connect Group Leader Training
- Be mindful & honorable in social media posts with how you conduct and present yourself
